Chargeable Items for County Residents

Applies to residents only

- Construction and demolition material: wood, sheet rock, sinks, toilets, tubs, siding, tile, vinyl and wood flooring, carpet, padding, insulation, roofing, kitchen/bathroom cabinets, counter tops, windows, doors, concrete, brick and stone
- Dirt and soils
- **Bulk trash**: docks, pier pilings, landscape timbers and telephone poles
- **Yard debris**: leaves, branches, tree trunks, shrubs and stumps
- Animal carcasses
- **Boats**: wood and fiberglass (remove fuel tanks, oil, batteries and motors)
- **Tires**: all car, truck, off-road and other tires on or off rims
- Mixed loads: a charge applies if household trash and/or recyclables is mixed with any of the above items

Commercial and Out-of-County Customers

Chargeable Items for Commercial and Out-of-County Customers

Applies to commercial haulers, commercial businesses, business self-haulers, out-of-county households, out-of-county commercial haulers

- MSW: household and commercial trash
- Construction and demolition material: wood, sheet rock, sinks, toilets, tubs, siding, tile, vinyl and wood flooring, carpet, padding, insulation, roofing, kitchen/bathroom cabinets, counter tops, windows and doors
- · Dirt and soils
- **Bulk trash**: furniture, docks, pier pilings, landscape timbers and telephone poles
- Yard debris: leaves, branches, tree trunks and shrubs; NO stumps
- Animal waste: from kennels, veterinary clinics, farms, etc.
- Animal carcasses
- **Boats**: wood and fiberglass (remove fuel tanks, oil, batteries and motors)
- Tires: all car, truck, off-road and other tires, on or off rims
- **Mixed loads**: a charge applies if household trash and/or recyclables is mixed with any of the above items
- Appliances
- Freon appliances (Appeal Landfill only)
- **Metal** (including heaters, pipes, plumbing, sheet metal, ducts, fencing, metal septic tanks, tubs, sinks, etc)
- Metal trailers, campers (tow behind only Appeal Landfill only – items must be free of all loose trash)

Oversized items, large furniture and Freon appliances must be brought to the Appeal Landfill. Commercial haulers must use the landfill, not the convenience center sites.



No-cost Disposal Items

Calvert County Residents and Calvert County Commercial

- **Appliances**

- **Metal** trailers, campers (tow behind only Appeal Landfill only – items must be free of all loose trash)

Special Bulk Pick-up Items

The Calvert County Division of Solid Waste offers county citizens free bulk item pick-up services. There is a limit of three items per pick-up, furniture and appliances ONLY. Call 410-326-0210 to schedule an appointment. The following items **can not** be picked up:

- Carpet
- Lawnmowers
- Heat pumps
- Cooking Grills

- Pianos
- Tractors/tillers
- Play equipment/toys
- Televisions / Electronics
- Outdoor furniture/picnic tables
- Farm equipment
- Pool / Game tables
- Exercise equipment

Sharps Disposal (syringes/lancets)

Syringes and lancets should be disposed of in a "SHARP" container specially designed to prevent them from sticking waste disposal workers and others. Please do NOT place them in a regular recyclable container.

Check with your local pharmacy for information on "SHARP" needle disposal containers. Needles and lancets from home healthcare may be disposed of in the normal household trash once placed in a "SHARP" container.
