1. REGULAR HOURS OF OPERATION ARE MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY 8 A.M TO 4 P.M.
2. STATION IS CLOSED ON ALL OFFICIAL COUNTY HOLIDAYS. A SIGN WILL BE POSTED ON SITE FOR ALL HOLIDAY CLOSINGS 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE.
3. BILLING IS DONE ON A MONTHLY BASIS. BILLS ARE DUE WITHIN 30 DAYS.
4. PERMITS ARE RENEWED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, AT THE TIME OF VEHICLE INSPECTION PERFORMED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT.
5. DUMPING AFTER NORMAL HOURS PERMITTED BY CALLING 443-684-3770. AN ADDITIONAL \$175.00 DUMPING FEE IS ADDED TO ALL NORMAL DUMPING FEES. ADVANCED NOTICE IS REQUIRED TO AVOID DELAYS FOR ARRIVAL OF COUNTY PERSONNEL TO THE STATION.
6. THE RATE FOR GREASE TRAPS is \$100.00 PER THOUSAND GALLONS. GREASE FROM GREASE TRAPS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM **IN-COUNTY TRAPS ONLY.**
7. ONLY RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL SANITARY WASTES ACCEPTED. NO INDUSTRIAL WASTES OF ANY KIND WILL BE ACCEPTED.
8. A MANIFEST WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EACH LOAD. EACH MANIFEST MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY.
9. UNLOADING WILL ONLY OCCUR IN THE PRESENCE OF THE ON SITE SEPTIC RECEIVING ATTENDENT OR OTHER WATER AND SEWER PERSONNEL.
10. EACH TRUCK WILL BE TESTED FOR PH PRIOR TO DUMPING. AN ACCEPTABLE PH IS BETWEEN 5.5 AND 10.0 AS PER THE CALVERT COUNTY SEWER USE ORDINANCE. THE SEPTIC RECEIVING ATTENDANT OR OTHER WATER AND SEWER PERSONNEL WILL DO A PRELIMINARY TEST ON SITE. A PRELIMINARY TEST RESULT INDICATING A PH LOWER OR HIGHER THAN THE ACCEPTABLE LIMITS WILL RESULT IN SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR A SECOND CONFIRMATION TEST AT THE SOLOMONS WWTP LAB. A CONFIRMATION TEST INDICATING A READING LOWER THAN 5.5 OR HIGHER THAN 10.0 WILL RESULT IN REFUSAL OF THE LOAD.
11. REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO PH TESTING, OR WILLFUL DISOBEYANCE OF THE POSTED REGULATIONS WILL RESULT IN DENIAL OF DUMPING PRIVILEGES.
