

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE NUMBER OF APPROVED DEPUTY SHERIFFS

WHEREAS, Section 2-309(f) of the *Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article* of the Maryland Annotated Code prescribes that “[t]he Sheriff may appoint deputy sheriffs in the number and at the salary approved by the County Commissioners;”

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has requested an amendment to the number of Deputy Sheriffs approved for this Fiscal Year 2015 such that the number of Deputy Sheriffs be as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Sheriff that all costs and expenses for one (1) of the four (4) new Deputy Sheriffs will be paid for in full by the Towns of North Beach and Chesapeake Beach;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the Sheriff that one (1) additional Deputy Sheriff will be hired in March 2015, but there will be a First Sergeant retirement at the end of FY 2015 to offset that increase in Fiscal Year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to approve the request to increase the number of Deputy Sheriffs upon the foregoing representations of the Sheriff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, that the portion of the table set forth at page 77 of the Fiscal 2015 approved and adopted Budget of Calvert County, Maryland constituting the approved Sheriff's Deputies is hereby redacted and, in its place shall be inserted the following:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be effective upon recordation and without publication of a fair summary.




