

St. Leonard Town Center Master Plan Update Kick-off Meeting January 22, 2008

Concerns Identification Assignment

In preparation of the St. Leonard Master Plan, which was adopted in 1995, the Department of Planning & Zoning hosted a workshop for area citizens to discuss and prioritize their concerns. These concerns were used to develop the goals and objectives, which formed the basis for the recommended actions, short range (1 to 10 years) and long range actions (10 to 20 years). Some of the actions have been accomplished since the Master Plan was adopted. The ranked list of concerns and the recommended actions are attached.

In September 2004, the St. Leonard Vision Group hosted a forum for local residents to discuss what they would like to see in their town. One outcome of that forum was a list of topics developed by participants. The list is attached.

Group Assignment:

Under the leadership of the facilitator complete the following:

1. Take 5 minutes to review the existing lists of concerns and silently write down any additional concerns which need to be addressed. Under the guidance of the facilitator, each individual will be asked to add one concern which should be added to the list, going around until all new concerns have been recorded.
2. Using the process identified in Item 5 from the "Participant Instructions" sheet, review the list of concerns as a group to ensure the concern statements are clearly stated. Once your group's list is complete, it will be posted with those of the other groups.
3. At the end of tonight's meeting, all individuals will be given five (5) dots with which to indicate their priority of the top concerns which need to be addressed.
