### An Energy Management and Energy Assistance Application Event

Energy Assistance Grants are available to help you pay your heating and energy bills.

#### Who Is Eligible?

Find your household size on the chart. If your monthly income is less than or equal to the amount below, you may be eligible for help with your energy bill. You do not need to have a turn-off notice to apply for energy assistance.

#### Income Eligibility

Effective July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010

Household Size	Maximum Monthly Income
1	\$1,579.37
2	\$2,124.79
3	\$2,670.20
4	\$3,215.62
5	\$3,761.04
6	\$4,306.45

(For each additional person, add \$545.42).

For energy assistance, please bring the following:

- *Government issued photo identification*
- *Proof of residence (lease, rent book, mortgage statement)*
- *Copies of Social Security Cards for all household members including children*
- *Proof of all of your household's total gross income for the last 30 days (from all sources of income)*
- *The name of your home energy supplier and account number*
- *A copy of your most recent utility bill*

This event is for ANYONE who has NOT yet applied for energy assistance during the period of July 1, 2009 to February 12, 2010.
