ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES

Per Resolution No. 48-87, the following are the Electrical Permit fees as adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County.

New Single Family Dwelling	
100 amp to 400 amp service	\$60.00
Modulars	\$35.00 plus any local work being installed by electrician – usually amounts to \$60.00

Additions & Alterations to Existing Buildings (2 inspections)	
1 to 15 outlets* (no service)	\$20.00
16 to 40 outlets* (no service)	\$40.00
Each additional 20 outlets over 40* (no service)	\$20.00
*Heating, cooking equipment and similar appliances will be included in outlet count.	

Service Installations (2 inspections)	
Pole Service	\$20.00
Residential Single-Family Dwelling Service	\$35.00

Swimming Pools	
Bonding and filter inspections	\$60.00

Mobile Homes (1 inspection)	
Service Only	\$20.00
Low Voltage (1 inspection)	\$20.00
Alarms, Telephones, Televisions, sound systems, public address systems and intercom systems. Emergency signaling systems – fire detection and alarms, fire sprinkler, water flow alarms, burglar alarm systems, security alarm and detection systems.	
Each Duplex, townhouse, apartment, etc. is treated as a separate unit for purposes of counting single family units.	

Outlets	
1 to 40	\$20.00
Each Additional 15	\$1.00 each
Switches, lighting fixtures or receptacles are counted as one outlet each.	

Motors – Generators – Transformers	
Single unit or group not exceeding 5 motors whose total capacity does not exceed 1 and greater H.P., K.W. or K.V.A. each	\$15.00

Service – Meter Equipment & Feeders	
Not Over 225 Amps	\$20.00
225 Amps to 400 Amps	\$30.00
400 Amps to 1000 Amps	\$40.00
1000 Amps and over	\$50.00

Heating, Cooking Equipment & Similar Appliances	
Outlet for single unit of 30 K.W. or less	\$10.00
Each additional unit, 30 K.W. or less	\$2.00
Cable Heat, first unit	\$10.00
Each Additional cable heat unit	\$2.00

Primary Transformers	
Vaults – Enclosures – Substations	\$50.00
Not over 200 K.V.A. each	\$50.00
200 K.V.A. to 500 K.V.A. each	\$50.00
Over 500 K.V.A. each	\$50.00

Electrical Signs – Incandescent	
Each sign	\$20.00

Electric Discharge Lighting Systems over 1000 Volts	
Up to 10 amps rating	\$20.00
Each additional 5 amp rating	\$5.00

Protective Signaling Systems	
First 15 devices	\$10.00
Each Additional 5 devices including branch circuit	\$5.00

Pneumatic Circuits	
First 2 circuits	\$20.00
Each additional circuit	\$5.00

Radio and Television Transmitters	
Each transmitter	\$50.00

Temporary Installations and Decorative Displays	
Not to exceed 60 days	\$20.00

Low Voltage Installation	
Burglar alarm, per sensing device	
Fire alarm, per sensing device	
Telephone outlet, per outlet	
Sound system, per speaker	
Data link (computer), per terminal	
CATV, per device	
Up to 40 units	\$15.00
Each additional 30 units or fraction	\$10.00




NOTE:

The minimum Electrical Fee is \$20.00.

Failure to secure an Electrical permit for either residential or non residential work will result in an assessment up to ten (10) times the required fee.

Applicable to all Building, Electrical, Grading and Plumbing Permits

A fee of \$30.00 will be assessed for the re-inspection of work made necessary by the placement of a STOP WORK ORDER.
