Calvert County residents can recycle the following materials for FREE.
Materials must be separated for drop-off.

- **Paper:** mixed newspaper, junk mail, cardboard, magazines, etc.; no pizza, milk or juice boxes
- **Commingle:** mixed aluminum and steel containers, glass and plastic bottles & aerosol (empty) – lids and labels may be left on
- **Metal:** all grades and forms of metal
- **Freon Appliances:** air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, water coolers
- **Motor Oil, Oil Filters and Antifreeze**
- **Propane Cylinders:** up to 100-pound bottles
- **Freon Cylinders:** up to 25 pound bottles
- **Batteries:** automotive and rechargeable batteries
- **Cell Phones:** no bagged phones
- **Electronics:** computers, monitors, keyboards and mice, televisions, DVD players, etc.
- **Bulbs:** compact fluorescent and fluorescent tubes, incandescent lamps, tubes and bulbs
- **Textiles:** all clothes, swatches, fabric, etc.
- **Cooking Oil:** up to 5 gallon containers
- **Printer Cartridges:** inkjet and laser

Convenience Centers will accept only bagged household trash and some recyclables.

Map, Operating Rules and Directions

- Map arrows show the direction of traffic.
- Watch for cross traffic, stopped traffic at intersections, and loading and unloading vehicles.
- Visitors are barred from restricted areas unless accompanied by landfill personnel.
- Visitors may park at the Administration Building for permit applications or other assistance.

Trash Transfer Station Safety Rules

- Wait for instructions on when to enter and where to stop and unload your vehicle.
- Commercial haulers are required to wear the following safety equipment when in the Trash Transfer Station: Safety vest, gloves, hard hat, safety glasses, and shoes.
- Be aware of potential hazards including trash or wet spots on the floor, unloading vehicles and heavy equipment.
- Children **MUST** stay in vehicle.
