

Breezy Point Beach and Campground

CAMPGROUND RULES

- Check-in time is between 5pm and 9pm. Quiet hours are from 10pm to 7am. Park must be notified of late arrivals or site will not be held. Cancellation of a campsite reservation must be made at least 48 hours in advance of the reservation date. Failure to do so may jeopardize future reservations.
- Any camper arriving before the 5pm check-in time will be charged one-half of the regular general admission fee. Any camper arriving before 1pm will be charged full general admission entrance fees.
- Please respect the rights of other campers: no disruptive behavior and keep music at a reasonable volume. Do not walk through the campsites of other campers.
- Pets, boats, and personal watercraft and their trailers are prohibited in the park.
- Open fires are permitted in fire barrels only (firewood not provided). Please deposit ashes from grills into the fire barrels and not onto the ground.
- Inclement weather is not grounds for a refund.
- Swimming is allowed in the designated area only. Wading up to waist depth will be permitted on the campers' beach.
- A responsible adult must accompany all children under 18. You are responsible for the actions of everyone in your party.
- Firearms and fireworks are prohibited. Fishing and crabbing are permitted with the appropriate licenses.
- Alcoholic beverages are permitted on your site only. Alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted on the beach, fishing pier, or bathhouse.
- Trash is to be disposed of in the dumpsters provided near the bathhouse. You are responsible for the disposal of your own trash.
- All campers and their guests MUST keep away from the rock jetties.
- Do not move picnic tables from one campsite to another.
- Tents must be set up near the water and electric outlets. Screen rooms, tables, and chairs may be set up under the trees.
- Trailers, pop-ups, and motor homes must park on the stone pad provided on your site, and must be backed into the spot.
- Only one vehicle may park on the site, and only on the stone pads provided (not in between the stone pads). Other vehicles must park across the street in the gravel parking lot. No unlicensed vehicles are allowed in the park.
- Keys to the front gate are available with a deposit at the park office; keys are for use after hours and must be returned at checkout.
- All guests must pay regular park admission fees and must exit the park at closing time.
- There is a maximum of 8 people permitted per campsite. Additionally, we permit only the following camping units: one (1) RV and one (1) tent; or two (2) tents.
- Any person may be evicted from the park for the breach of any of these rules or other rules, verbal or written, which may be in effect. All fees shall be forfeited in the event of eviction.
- We reserve the right to make changes in your site number regardless of original scheduling.
