PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – January 21, 2010 – The Calvert County Division of Parks and Recreation has established fees and operational hours for the soon-to-be-completed Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center in Prince Frederick.

General admission fees will be as follows:

The facility will include a 50-meter competition pool, leisure pool with slides, therapy pool, spa, fitness room and meeting and party rooms for rent.

Passes will go on sale starting February 1, 2010, at the main office of the Division of Parks and Recreation at 205 Main Street in Prince Frederick, Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Passes will be available at the Edward T. Hall Aquatic Center once it opens.

General operating hours will be Monday through Friday, 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday 8 a.m. to 10 p.m.

Doug Meadows, chief of the Division of Parks and Recreation, admits that the county does not yet have a certain date for the pool's opening but ensures that construction is on track. "We are still expecting the pool to open in early spring of 2010," Meadows said. "We all recognize how highly anticipated this opening is and construction crews are adhering to a tight schedule in order to guarantee a timely and smooth grand opening. As soon as we have a definite date, it will be announced and posted to our Web site."
